



It also sees to it that each church has an identical organizational pattern so that they can cooperate and intercommunicate.




This takes a long time, but it assures us that we as Methodists are effective in our out-reach.

Representatives from throughout the jurisdiction assemble for a conference every 4 years to elect bishops.


